



South Orange-Maplewood School District

Revised 2012-2013 School Calendar

November 19, 2012 – The Board of Education approved changes to the 2012-2013 School Calendar to offset days schools were closed due to Hurricane Sandy and to provide flexibility in case schools are forced to close again this year for snow or other emergent conditions. All schools will now be in session on Thursday, February 14, 2013 (originally scheduled to be part of Winter Recess).

With this change, no schools currently owe any additional make-up days, although three schools no longer have emergency closing days available:

If any school is closed for inclement weather or other emergency for more than the allotted days, the first make-up day will be during Spring Recess beginning with April 8, 2013, working forward to April 12, 2013 as needed, or at the end of the school year if emergency closings occur after April 12, 2013.

Any school which still has emergency closing days available as of May 23, 2013, will have “give back days” scheduled as follows:

- 1 emergency day remaining – school will be closed on Friday, May 24, 2013 (Memorial Day weekend).
- 2 emergency days remaining – school will be closed on both Friday, May 24, and Tuesday, May 28, 2013 (Memorial Day weekend).

BACKGROUND

SOMSD set aside three days for emergency closings in 2012-2013. However, the District was closed for five days as a result of Hurricane Sandy, and some schools were closed for additional days. The District added make-up days in November by adjusting the schedule to have school in session on November 6 (previously scheduled to be a professional development day for staff) and November 8 and 9 (previously scheduled to be closed for the NJEA Convention).

The adjustment left three schools needing to make up one day before the end of the year, one school with no emergency closing days available, and five schools with only one emergency closing day left. The Board of Education then allotted Thursday, February 14, 2013, as a regular school day, to preserve Spring Recess for as many schools as possible.
